

Poor Farm

The county court has purchased from J. R. Horning sixty acres of land on the Keno road and but a short distance from this city, paying therefor \$1,500. It is claimed the court has for some time been considering the advisability of mak-

ing such a purchase and it is alleged that several locations were investigated. The first the public knew of this contemplated action was when the deal was consummated. It would seem that where the county court intended to make such a move it would have asked for bids. While it is possible that no bid would be submitted that would be better

than the price paid Mr. Horning, nevertheless the court owes it to the taxpayers of the county to make a show of seeking a site in the open market. \$1,500 is a good deal of money to tie up in a proposition for which there is no apparent necessity and adds an additional burden on the taxpayers when the load they are now carrying is already too heavy.

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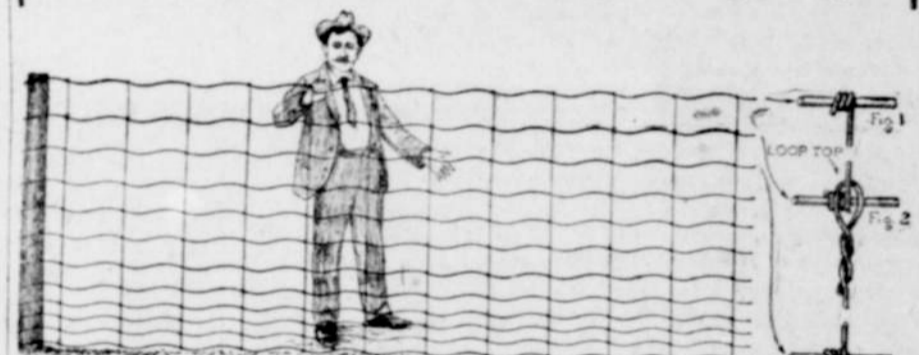
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
