Ralph Evans of Dorris was in the city this week.

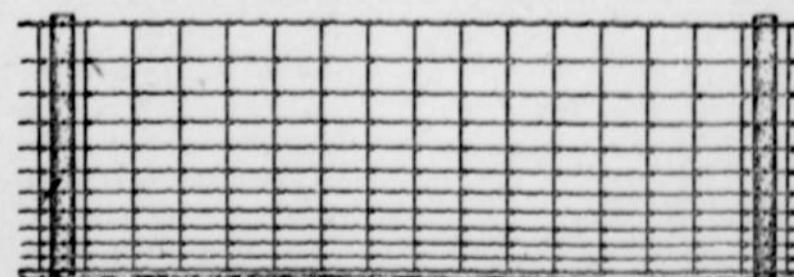
