CLOPTONS ARE BOUND OVER TO THE NEXT GRAND JURY

In the case of the State of Oregon vs. Mr. and Mrs. Hugh Clopton, who are charged with being responsible for the fire in Bonanza which destroyed the postoffice and other buildings last winter, the defendants were bound over in the sum of \$1,500 each to await the action of the next grand jury by Justice of the Peace E. W. Goowen Wednesday morning at the conclusion of the hearing in his court. No witnesses were introduced by the defense, attorneys deeming it unnecessary, as the matter was bound to go to the grand jury before settlement.

The prosecution, however, clearly established two very important facts by its witnesses. One of these facts is that the city of Bonanza needs a town clock to regulate the various timepieces possessed by inhabitants of the thriving burg, for by their testimony this morning the fire was discovered all the way from 1 o'clock to 1:45 by persons "who looked at the clock" at the time.

The other important fact revealed is that Mrs. Clopton slept "with her hair up," for numerous witnesses for the prosecution testified seeing her soon after the fire was discovered, and "her hair was up"—whatever that means.

As to what started the fire, that seems to have been lost sight of in the earnest quest of a solution of why Mrs. Clopton's "hair was up."

RESIGNATION OF SMITH ACCEPTED

The resignation of Joseph C. Smith as chief of police was read at Tuesday night's council meeting by Mayor T. F. Nicholas, and was accepted by the council after two votes were taken.

Following the reading of the resignation, Councilman Doty moved that it be laid over a week. He held that the council ought to look into the causes of the flaccid encounter between the chief and Charles Martin Saturday night, and hold a hearing.

"I can't see why we shouldn't allow him to resign if he wants to," said Townsend. "He hasn't asked for a hearing."

A vote upon Doty's motion resulted in a tie, Goeller, Hamilton, Underwood, Owens and Doty voting yes, and Rogers, Matthews, Townsend, Savidge and Cantrill voting in the negative. Mayor Nicholas then voted in the negative.

Savidge then moved for the immediate acceptance of the resignation, which was adopted.

No announcement as to a successor was made by the mayor.

NAME TWO MORE H. S. TEACHERS

At a meeting of the Klamath County High School board Wednesday, George Schmitzer of Wilkes-Barre, Pa., was elected as head of the commercial department of the high school. Earl Chandler, selected to fill McCall's place as agricultural instructor, was also chosen for next year.

A course in stenotypy is to be added to the commercial department next year.

The board at this meeting also authorized the purchase of 200 steel lockers, for the keeping of the wraps, etc., of the students.

TO FINISH ETNA MILLS SCHOOL

W. D. and C. C. Cofer of the firm of Cofer Bros. George Hicks and R. J. Sheets left this morning for Etna Mills, Calif.

The firm of Cofer Bros. was awarded the contract for a \$30,000 high school in the California town last year, and are returning to complete their work. R. J. Sheets of the Link River Electric company has the contract for wiring the building and installing electrical fixtures.

The plumbing also went to a local firm, Baxter & Malone being selected for this work.

About two months' work remains to be done when the building will be turned over to the authorities.

LIBRARY FINISH CONTRACTS MADE

Contracts for the finishing of the \$24,000 Carnegie Library, in course of construction near the new court house, were let this morning by the county court.

The contract for the tile roof was awarded to the Klamath Sheet Metal works, and for the electrical work to the Link River Electrical company.

This far the plumbing has not been awarded. The bid of E. C. Greeley was the lowest submitted, and in all probability the contract will be made late today.
