NEW IRRIGATION DISTRICT TO BE FORMED LOCALLY

Instead of the Tuttle project being conducted by the Willow Valley Irrigation company, it will in all probabilities be handled by an irrigation district, to be known as the Willow Valley Irrigation District.

The Willow Valley project will irrigate 4,600 acres of land between Lorella and Langell Valley postoffices, and east of the Horsely project.

The dam and other parts of the works have been built by R. F. Tuttle for the company in which he, the Duncans and others are interested, and it is expected that by the time the district is formed, etc., that the project will be fully completed.

The cost of the project will be \$15 an acre. The company intends to finish the project and turn it over to the district at a figure not to exceed this amount, including all water rights, filings, ditch rights of way, etc.

In addition to making the price less than \$15 an acre, it is understood that the company is also willing to take bonds of the district at par for the payment of the project's cost. This settles in advance the price of the work, the disposal of the bonds and other matters.

Astoria and Portland merchants are co-operating to find a market for the product of the new Astoria flouring mills.

HOMESTEADS ARE SETTling FAST

"The homestead lands thrown open in the northern part of the county are settling up rapidly," says Joseph L. Ringo, an engineer and hotel owner of Crescent, who was a county seat visitor Monday.

"There is hardly a day but what five or six homesteaders reach Crescent in search of homestead lands. The greater portion of the choice homestead lands is gone, but there is still some excellent timber land available.

"In addition to those who are seeking homesteads, buyers for the Hunter Land company's tracts are coming in. The land company has a motor service between Kirk and Crescent, and will do much experimental farm work to prove the productivity of its lands."

Ringo is now the owner of the Crescent hotel, his partner, Eddie Santry, having disposed of his interests and moved out on his homestead.

GROOM HEARING OVER FIVE DAYS

The preliminary hearing of Jay Groom on charge of burglarizing the James Dixon store at Fort Klamath and taking therefrom \$80, will be held Saturday. This was agreed upon Tuesday by both sides in Justice Gowen's court.

Both the state and Groom will summon a number of witnesses, as Groom maintains he is innocent.

Bishop 35 Votes Short.

The official count of the ballots, which was completed late today, gives Hawxhurst 309 votes to 274 for Bishop, for the democratic nomination for sheriff, giving Hawxhurst a majority of 35 votes.

LINDSEY SHOCKED OVER ATROCITIES IN STRIKE CENTER

CHICAGO, May 19.—Judge Ben Lindsey passed through here today en route to Washington, accompanying Mrs. Pearl Jolly and two other women survivors of the Ludlow fatalities.

Lindsey says the details of the affair at Ludlow are unbelievable, and are only equalled by the stories of the sacking of Rome, the pillage of Carthage and the inhumanities of the Balkan war.

"The Colorado militia men are now sitting on a volcano," said the Judge. Withdraw the federal troops, and there will be a war of reprisal so terrible that one shudders to contemplate it.

"We are going to Washington to beg President Wilson not to withdraw the regular troops from the strike district. That would mean a worse war than before.

"My own interest in this is neutral. I want to see law and order restored. The citizens of Denver asked me to help get order, but I want it because the true story of what took place at Ludlow is too horrible to print."

SINNOTT SECURES ANOTHER APPOINTMENT FOR K. F. BOY

"You passed a fine examination for Annapolis, also your principal did. As the principal under another appointment did not report for the examination, I have substituted your name as principal. You will be notified by the navy department to appear at Annapolis for physical examination by the middle of June."

The foregoing telegram, received today by W. Stirling Garrett from Congressman N. J. Sinnott, insures the local youth of an opportunity to enter Uncle Sam's naval academy and study to be an officer in the navy, acquiring at the same time a four and a half year university course that cannot be duplicated in any other institution.

Garrett and Leon Boller of this city were named as alternates in the recent competition held, and both took the entrance examination. It is understood that Boller passed a very flattering examination, and would also have been named for Annapolis had there been another vacancy.

Young Garrett is the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. H. Garrett of this city, and is a student at the Klamath county high school, where he stands high in scholarship, and has quite a reputation in athletic circles. As to his successfully passing the physical examination for admission into Annapolis, there is not the least room for doubt.
