Karl Marlantes awarded Clarkson University honorary degree

Author Karl Marlantes, a Seaside High School graduate, was awarded an honorary doctor of science degree at Clarkson University's 123rd Commencement on Saturday, May 7. The degree was awarded for "answering this country's call to duty; for his bravery and compassion in war; for his work developing sustainable energies and their infrastructure; for documenting the experiences that illuminate the realities of war and for giving voice to veterans and helping them on their paths to recovery; and for his service to this nation and to humanity."
