Seaside gambled on a few fourth down plays, and came up big to win the nonleague contest at Broadway Field, as the Gulls improve to 1-1.

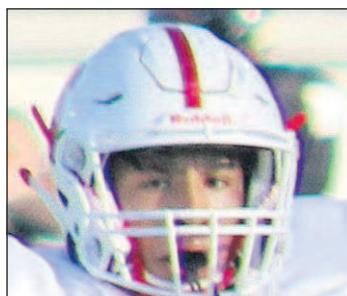
No fourth down play was bigger than the one right before halftime.
