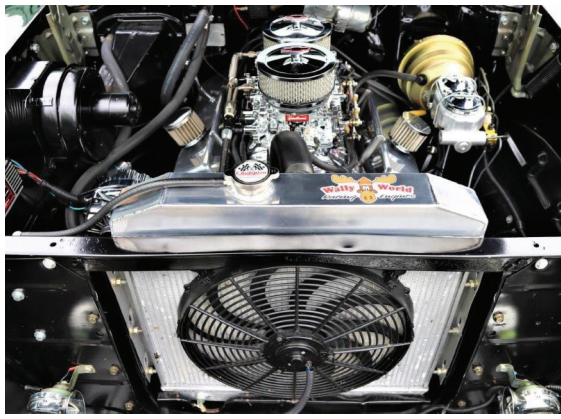


WHEELS AND WAVES 2019
