

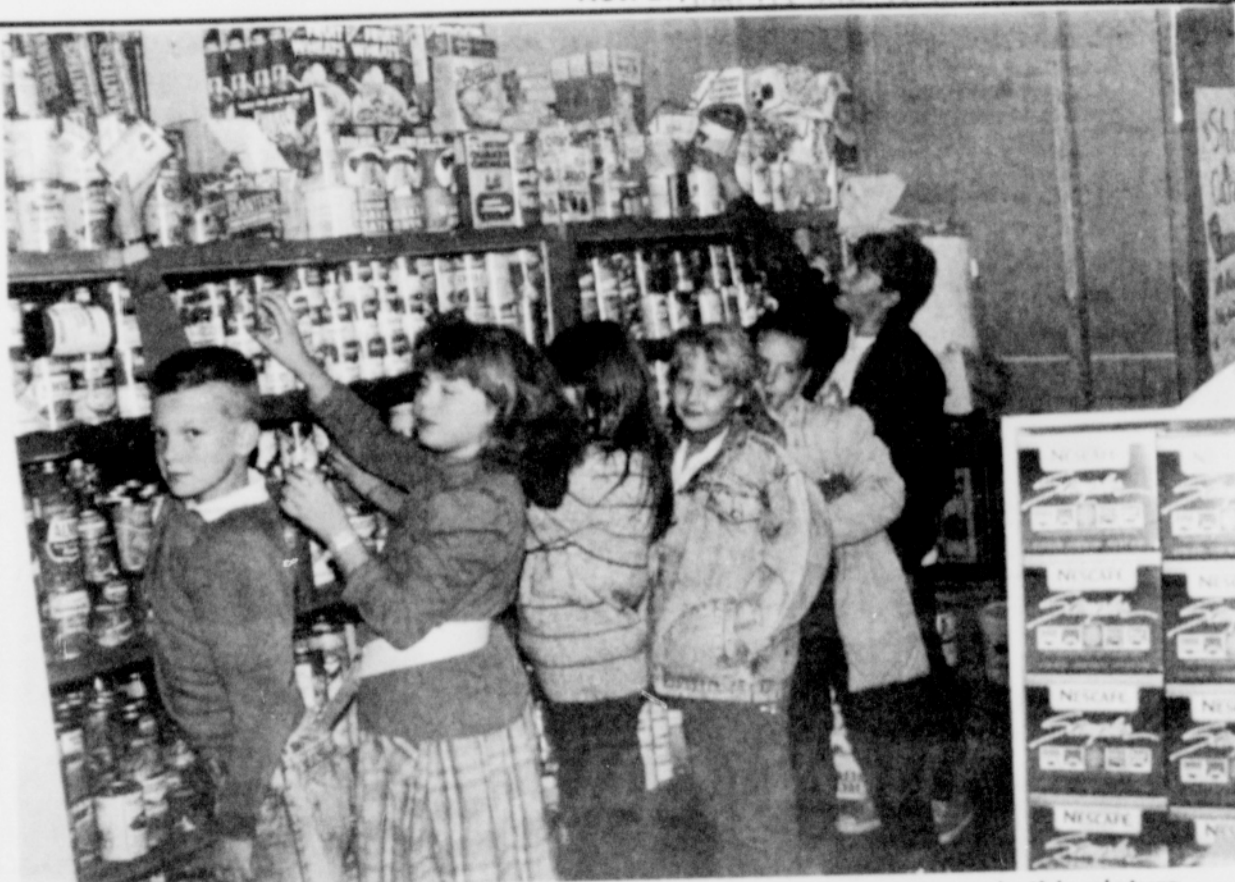

4-H club's efforts bring in mountains of food

"They brought in a ton of food," said a happy Vernonia Cares president, Dorothy Yadon, as she watched boxes, barrels and bags of donated food being delivered to the emergency food program by 4-H Club members.

Sponsored by the Misty Meadows 4-H Horse Club, the seven day food drive used competition between school classrooms as the impetus for a highly successful effort.

The winning class will receive an ice cream social and movie, while the runners-up will be treated to a popcorn party and movie.

Club members took a daily count in each classroom, decorated donation boxes and packed all of the food for delivery to Vernonia Cares. Parents helped with the deliveries.

While the food drive was in

progress, the Vernonia Food Crew, a 4-H cooking club, made 21 dozen cookies for the Christmas boxes that will be distributed to needy families by Vernonia Cares.

The Food Crew made the cookies in one day, keeping 4 ovens going in the Washington Grade School cafeteria while they worked. Though there was adult supervision, the members did all of the work.

Leaders who helped in the effort were Kelly Schaumburg, Judy Pieren, Linda Gibson, Judy Nerheim and Dolores Fowler.



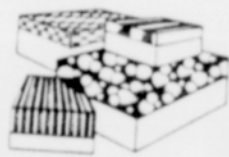
