

## First county fine arts festival planned

Entries for the first Columbia County Fine Arts Festival are coming in strong, but there is still time and space for more entries, according to Paul Carr, president of the Columbia Arts Guild.

The festival is scheduled for August 11-12 at the Columbia County Fairgrounds, but the deadline for entries is July 1, 1990. The extra time is to accommodate judging of the entries and

make sure adequate space is available for the number of entries expected.

"We will have space available for booths where the artist can display and sell, as well as a fine art juried show," Carr said. He explained that all artists accepted for the show are eligible to enter one or two of their pieces for the juried show. The Guild will provide recognition awards to participating artists.

In addition to the artwork on display at the fairgrounds, the festival will include performances on the outdoor stage by a variety of musical groups, and at least one artist will perform original humorous pieces.

There will be painting demonstrations including "quick draws," which the artist must complete in less than one hour. Viewers will be able to bid on these paintings.

Several Oregon wineries and cheese companies have signed on to provide wine and cheese tasting during the festival. If these aren't to your liking, Carr said, there will be other interesting foods available.

All artists entering the fine arts festival will be asked to send the guild three returnable slides or photos of their work. For entry information or forms, call Carr at 543-7280 in Scappoose.

Work is progressing rapidly on the Vernonia Health Center and an opening is in sight, with a projected dedication date some time in August.

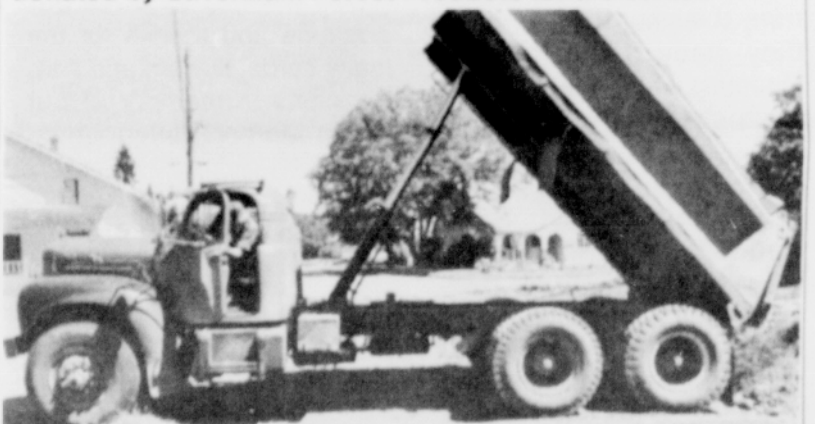
Funds are still urgently needed to complete the project, according to Barbara Ervin, and she urges citizens
