Herbert (12-14 yr girl), Jon Mulleda (8-11 yr boy) and Mathew Sterling (6-7 yr boy).



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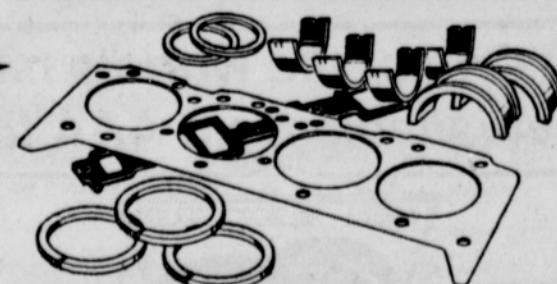
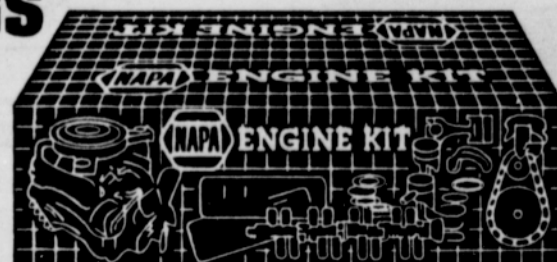
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
