

New golf course under construction near Banks

Construction is in full swing at the new Quail Valley Golf Course near Banks. Plans call for tee time availability for

this public play course in late May or early June of 1994.

Large earth moving equipment is relocating more than

300,000 cubic yards of dirt to create the golf course on the 160 acre site near the Banks reservoir.

"Excavation of four large lakes will create twelve acres of water to provide irrigation and add to the challenge and quality of play of the golf course", says Ron Mack, managing partner of Quail Valley Golf Corp.

Golf course designer John Zoller of Vancouver, Washington, has designed the course as an up-scale layout that is challenging to the serious golfer but also fair to the intermediate and new golfer.

The fairness was developed with four sets of elevated tee-boxes to accommodate all levels of play. The front tee-box will be approximately 5,500 yards, progressing from there to the championship tee-box at 6,800 yards.



This gently rolling terrain will be transformed into the Quail Valley Golf Course.

Rather than the traditional tree lined fairway layout, Quail Valley Golf Course is being built by Bernhardt Golf of Beaverton, through mounding, cuts and undulations that essentially carve the golf course out of the natural terrain. Many of the new golf courses being created nationally are using this approach to modern golf course design.

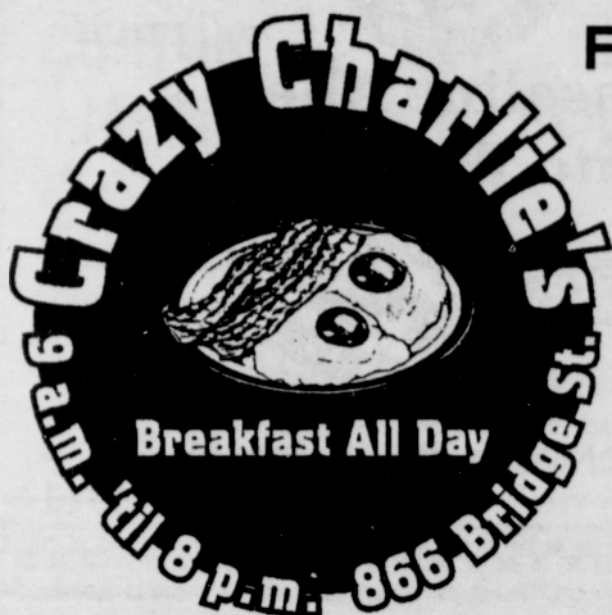
For putting quality, bent grass will be planted on the U.S.G.A. constructed greens with rye grass used for the

fairways. Tan, U.S.G.A. approved, sand will be used in the sand traps.

The golf course site was selected by the local investment group for its proximity to major highways and ease of access. Golfers can easily drive to the site from U.S. 26 via either Highway 6 or Highway 47.

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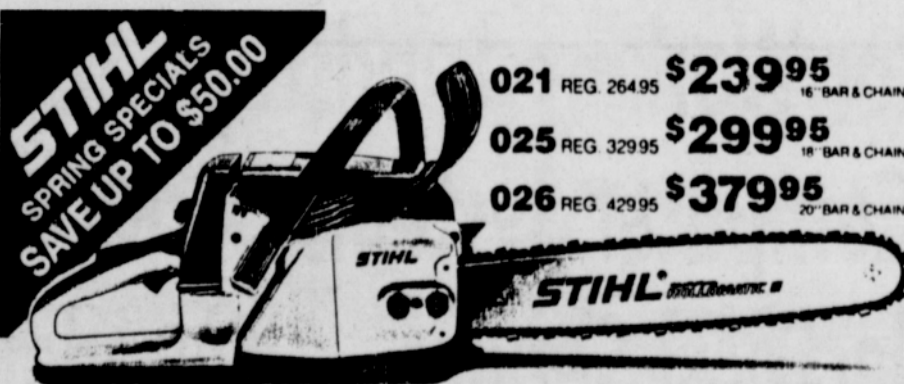
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
