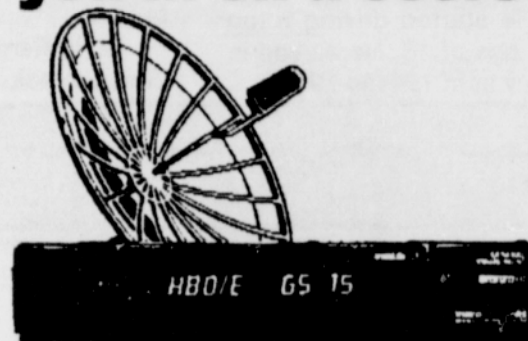
The purpose of the meeting is to receive the budget message and document of the district.
