

U.S. Postal Service examination slated to create list of "eligibles"

The United States Postal Service will accept applications from the general public to establish a register of eligibles for processing, distribution and delivery positions. A Postal examination is required to be placed on this register and the examination will apply to those offices beginning with the ZIP Codes of 972, 970, 971 and 986.

Applications for these positions will be accepted from Monday, April 25, through Friday, April 29, 1994. Applicants will be notified by mail of the examination date.

Anyone who is 18 years of age or a high school graduate is eligible to apply. Applicants will be required to take a written examination designed to test aptitude for learning and performing the duties of the above positions.

Starting hourly salaries for these positions range from \$10.12 to \$12.26.

Application for this Postal examination can be made at the Portland Post Office or most larger offices with the ZIP code of 972, 970, 971 and 986.

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State parks will provide part-time worker in city park

The City of Vernonia will receive part-time help in Anderson Park by providing space there for an Oregon Department Of Parks "Host." The state Park Host program allows people to stay free in certain state parks in exchange for part-time work.

In Vernonia, the state will provide a Park Host who will spend half of the required time working on the Banks-Vernonia Linear Park and half of it working in Anderson Park. The hosts stay for approximately one month at a time.

The city has also hired a new caretaker for Anderson Park. Bob Ensign has now taken over the job of maintenance and fee collections in the popular park.

Council members discussed some sample ordinances regarding logging within city limits. The discussion included consideration of what a city logging permit should include. Mayor Tony Hyde asked the councilors to study the resolutions and ordinances provided and be ready to make suggestions at the next council meeting.
