The failure to raise an issue at the hearing, in person or by letter, or the failure to provide sufficient specificity to afford the Commission an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to the Board of County Commissioners based on that issue.

At the hearing, the applicant has the burden of presenting substantial evidence showing that the application meets all of the applicable criteria. Following presentation of the staff report, the applicant and other persons in favor of the application will be allowed to address the Commission, explaining how the evidence submitted meets the applicable criteria.

Following the applicant's presentation, any person in opposition to the application may present evidence and argument against the application. The ap-

plicant will then have an opportunity to rebut any evidence or arguments presented in opposition. After the presentation of evidence and arguments, the public hearing record will be closed.

The Commission will then make a tentative decision to be followed by approval of a written order and a statement of findings and conclusions supporting the decision, which will be mailed to all parties at a later date. The Commission may, at its discretion, continue the hearing from time to time at the request of the parties or on its own motion as necessary to afford substantial justice and comply with the law.
