

Vernonia Police Department report for June

In June, 1994, the Vernonia Police Department arrested three individuals on outstanding warrants. All three were transported and lodged in the Columbia County Jail. The charges on the warrants were resisting arrest, parole violation and felony driving while suspended.

Six separate locations were posted with nuisance abatement orders. The nuisances were regarding unsightly junk on or about the property. All six complied with the orders by cleaning up the property.

June 11, three juveniles were arrested for curfew violations. All three were released to their parents and referred to the Columbia County Juvenile Department.

Three individuals were cited for allowing dogs to be a public nuisance.

June 17, at about 4:35 p.m., an individual was arrested for disorderly conduct. Police were advised that a male subject was causing a disturbance in front of U.S. Bank and was extremely intoxicated. Subject was trans-

ported and lodged in the Columbia County Jail.

June 23rd and 24th Vernonia Police investigated two criminal mischief complaints in which tires were slashed on vehicles on E. Bridge Street near Vernonia Lake. The two incidents may be related. Anyone with information on these crimes please con-




