

Paving will delay motorists on Hwy. 47

Construction has started on a \$1-million preservation project on Highway 47 between Banks and Forest Grove, between Mile Post 84 and 89.4.

The scope of the 5-mile project includes asphalt paving, shoulder reconstruction and mailbox support replacement. The work is designed to improve roadway conditions.

A unique paving material—F-Mix—will be used to surface the highway. The new asphalt pavement improves visibility by reducing road spray from

other vehicles and also lowers the risk of hydroplaning. During wet weather, water drains through the porous asphalt and then to the sides of the highway.

Motorists can expect 10 to 15 minute delays during site preparation and initial paving activities. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car will guide motorists through the work zone. Paving activities and traffic delays will continue for approximately seven weeks. Work is scheduled between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. each day, Monday

through Friday.

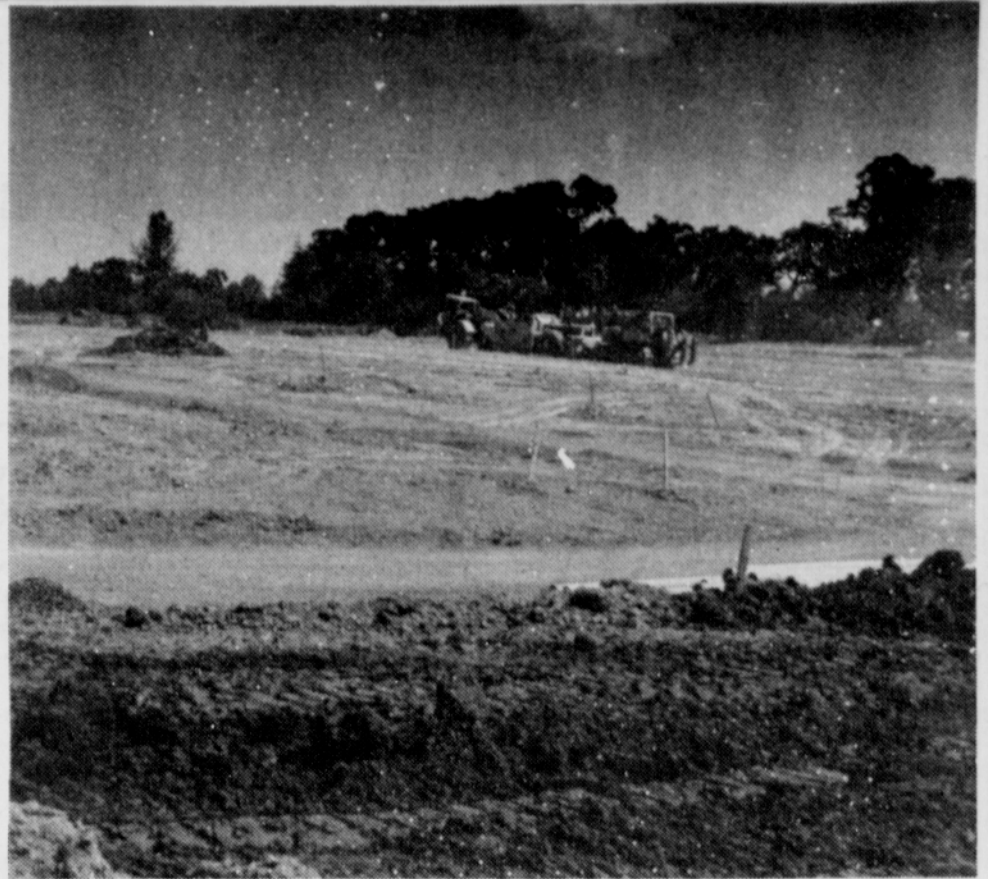
The contractor, Morse Brothers, Inc. of Sherwood, anticipates a July 31, 1995, completion date.

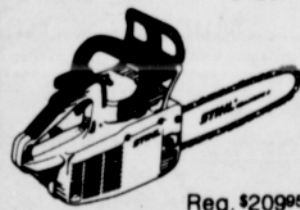

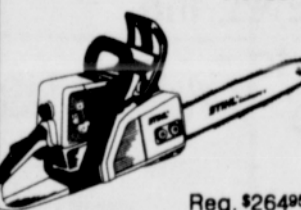

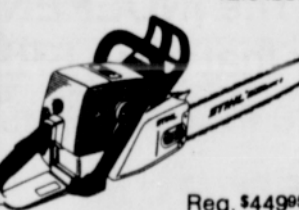
