

Pacific University Art Series presents wide variety of programs

Pacific University has scheduled an eclectic mix of performers for its 1995-96 Performing Arts Series.

All shows will be held in the Taylor-Meade Performing Arts Center, McCready Hall.

Two season subscription packages are offered. Full subscriptions are \$65 each. Purchasers may also choose

three or more shows and receive a 10 percent discount. Individual tickets range from \$14 to \$20 each and may be purchased from the Pacific University Box Office at (503) 359-2918, or through Fred Meyer FASTIXX outlets, 1-800-922-TIXX.

The series starts Sept. 24, with a performance by the

Trail Band, a group that makes the history of the Oregon Trail come alive. Oct. 15 will feature a performance by The London Baroque, one of the foremost exponents of baroque chamber music.

Judy Collins, with more than two dozen albums in her three decade career, will perform Nov. 18. The fiery Latin jazz of Poncho Sanchez & His Latin Band will play Feb. 23. The series concludes with a show by the Windham Hill quartet, Nightnoise, March 30.

Two special events will supplement the series. Handel's Messiah will kick off the holiday season Dec. 3. On March 2, the 3rd Annual Stars

in the Grove community concert will take place. Tickets for either of these shows are

\$5 for adults, \$3 for students/seniors. They are available by calling the Box Office.

would employ approximately 220 workers at annual salaries in the \$40,000 range.

The GSPC authorizes formal investigations for about half the cases brought before it, according to a department spokesman. A formal investigation allows investigators to interview witnesses under oath and subpoena records.

Violations of state ethics rules are punishable by a

maximum fine of \$1,000 per violation and up to twice the amount of financial gain, if it is determined that an official used his office for personal gain.

The investigation must be completed by early December. It will then be reviewed by the commission, which will hold a public meeting to consider whether ethics violations have occurred.
