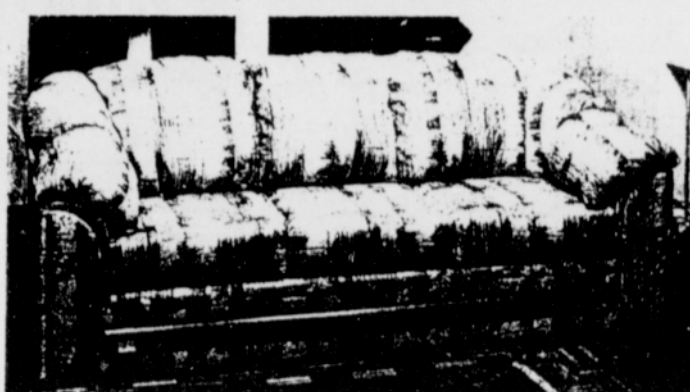

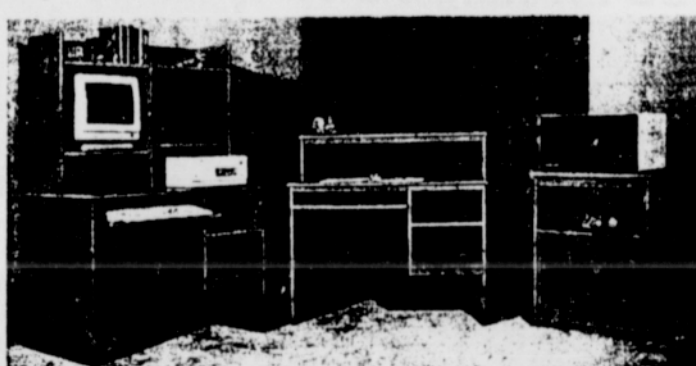

"Together We Can Make a Difference" is the theme of St. Helens Jaycees' Port O' Fun, which begins today and continues through Saturday. Most activities will be in the Old Towne section, but the whole town will be involved.

The carnival will be open every day, along with lots of food and crafts booths. The city-wide Sidewalk Sale will also start on Wednesday and continue through Saturday. Thursday night, the Port O' Fun queen will be crowned at Stage One.

Thursday will be Kids Day at the carnival, with a \$10 bracelet that provides unlimited rides from noon to 10:00 p.m.

Friday, the Thirst Station will be open from 5:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. with music by The Strange, starting at 9:00 p.m.

The Grand Parade will start at noon on Saturday, from in front of Mountain View Motors, march down Columbia Blvd. to First Street and end in Olde Towne.

Also on Saturday there will be a Cruise In beginning at 2:00 p.m. at the Columbia County Courthouse parking lot, plus a full schedule of auto racing on the quarter-mile oval at RiverCity Speedway, at the County Fairgrounds.

The Thirst Station will open at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, with music provided by Zozu Blue, starting at 9:00 p.m.
