FCC approves school and library discounts

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has voted unanimously to provide schools and libraries with discounted rates (e-rates) on everything from basic telephone service to state-of-the-art video-conferencing, beginning Jan. 1, 1998. Included will be internet access and internal wiring or networking.

Discounts will range from 20 to 90 percent on a sliding scale. The amount of the discounts will be determined by geographic location, with the lowest rates going to rural, high-cost, low-income communities. The percentage of students eligible for free or reduced-price lunches will also be factored in the calculations.
