"We have a great line-up of performers for this year's fair," said fair board member Toni Nelson. "There will be plenty of fun for the whole family."

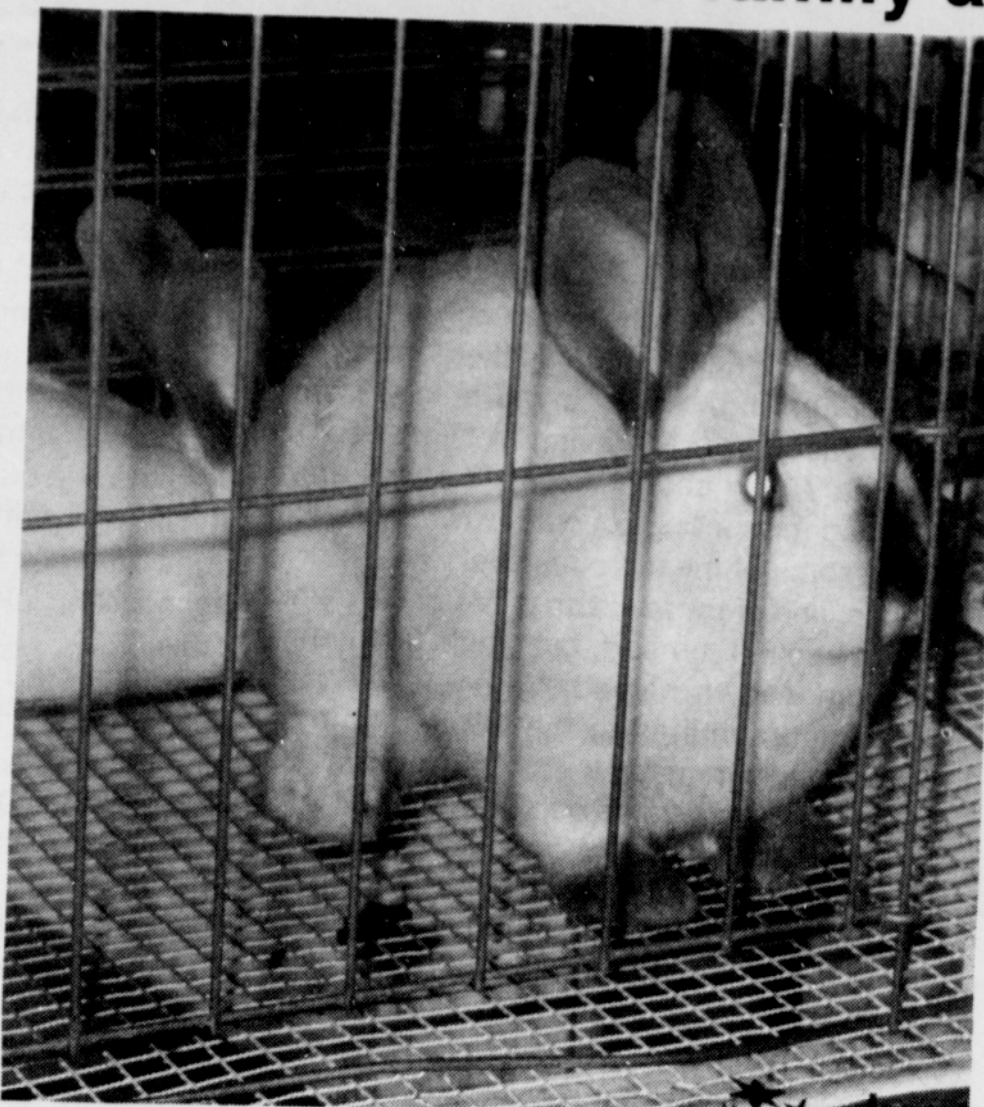
All entertainment is included in the price of fair admission.
