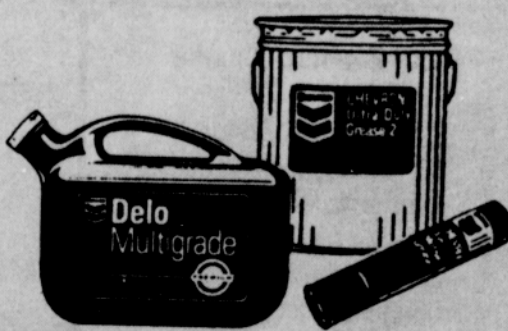
Leaf Contest winners
