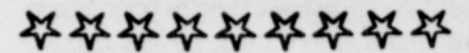

higher positions in the department, or who were using this back door maneuver extensively, were given one-to-two week unpaid suspensions. Monetarily, this resulted in at least a \$1,000 dollar fine for the people involved. There is one aspect that I feel Director Greer left unresolved. I think it is obvious that some people were denied tags because of his staff's actions and are thus entitled to some compensation. I feel that everyone who was denied a tag because of these inappropriate employee tactics should have been notified so they could take legal recourse. With fee hunting operations in Eastern Oregon receiving upwards of \$5,000 for elk hunts, the scale is set for financial retribution.
