Banks Council moves funds where needed

Banks City Council, at its regular meeting February 8, approved a resolution to increase the appropriation for materials and services by \$36,083. The increase was achieved by transferring funds from other items in the General Fund; it will not change the total budget.

The council felt that increased spending on services occurred primarily because the City has needed more services from consultants and professionals in connection with exceptional projects in the community.

Dexter Clark of Voice Stream spoke to the council

about the possibility of installing a 130' communications tower in Banks. Placing it behind the library was discussed, but the council felt the location was wrong for a large, unattractive structure in the downtown area. It would also usurp space needed for parking or other City priorities.

In other business, the Council:

- Approved liquor license renewals for Jim's Sentry Supermarket, Main Street Pizza, and Banks Billiards Tavern;

- Approved an expenditure of \$1000 for the Banks welcome sign. The sign will cost

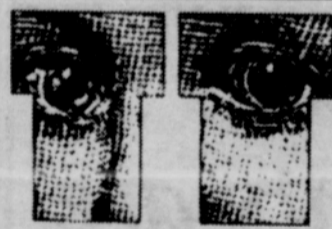
