## Vernonia Head Start registration

Head Start, a federally funded pre-school, is seeking students for the 2000-2001 school year. Applications are being taken from all three and four year olds.

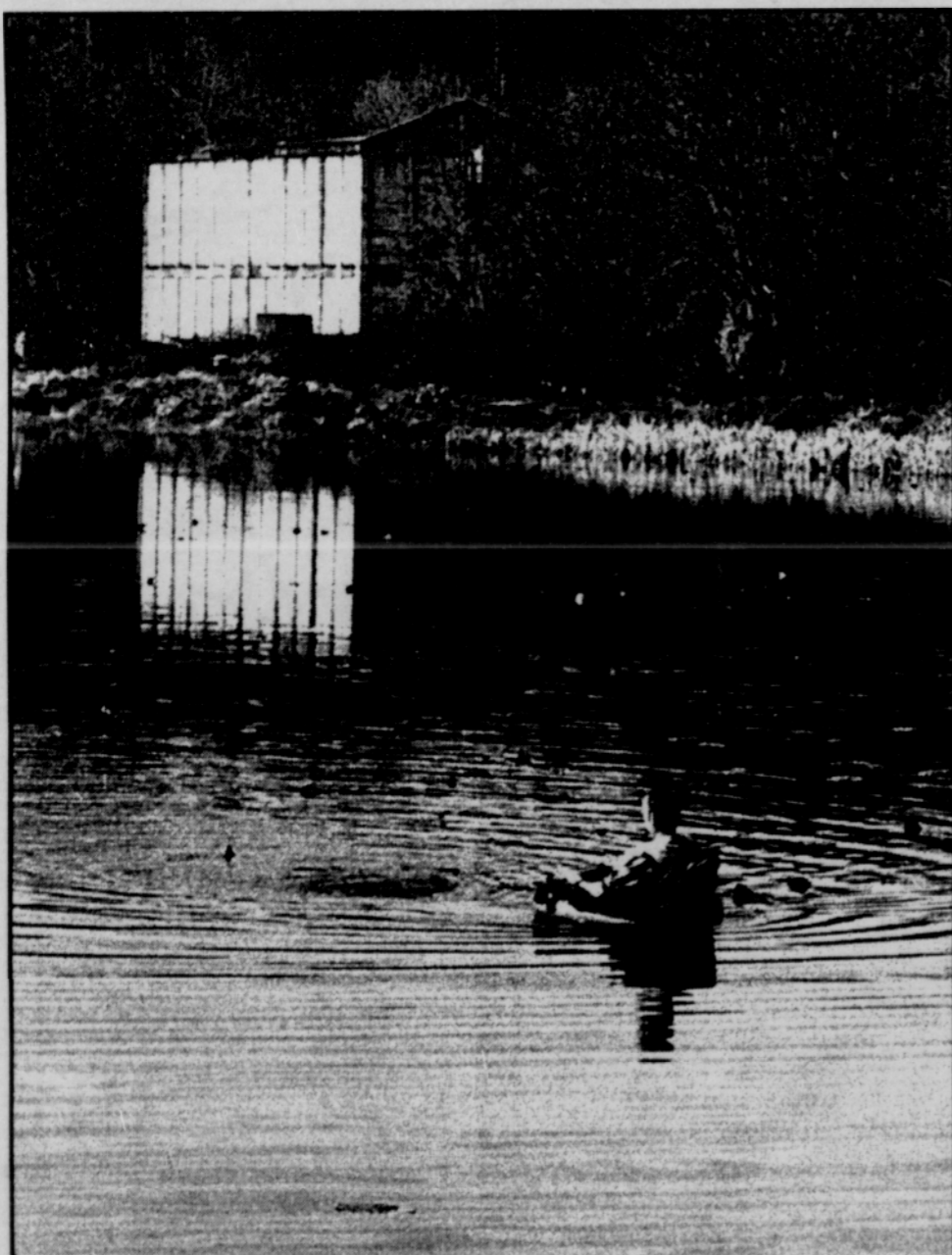
Prospective students must have turned three before September 1, 2000. Children must be from low income households, or have a disability and/or special needs to qualify.

Head Start incorporates a total family program that includes nutrition, education, and medical and dental services for the enrolled child. USDA ap-

proved meals are served. Training on various subjects and on-the-job training is offered to all enrolled families. The program is open to children regardless of race, sex, creed, nationality, or disabling condition.
