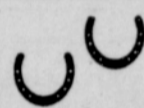

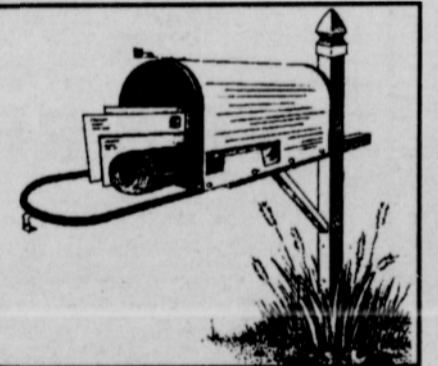

## Obituary

### HAZEL M.L. VOLPP

Hazel Marie Lauretta Volpp, 91, North Plains, died June 21, 2000, at Tuality Community Hospital in Hillsboro, of pneumonia. Graveside services were held at Union Point Cemetery in Banks, with Reverend Eric Otum of the Calvary Lutheran Church in Hillsboro, officiating.

Mrs. Volpp was born June 26, 1908, on a farm near Bloomfield, Neb., to Christian Friederick and Wilhemina "Rose" Lena (Cook) Utecht. She was raised in the Bloomfield area.

She married Paul William Volpp in 1931, at Elk Point, S. Dak. They farmed in the Bloomfield area until 1935, when they moved to Greenville, near Banks, then six months later, to North Plains. In 1941, they moved to their present home in North Plains.
