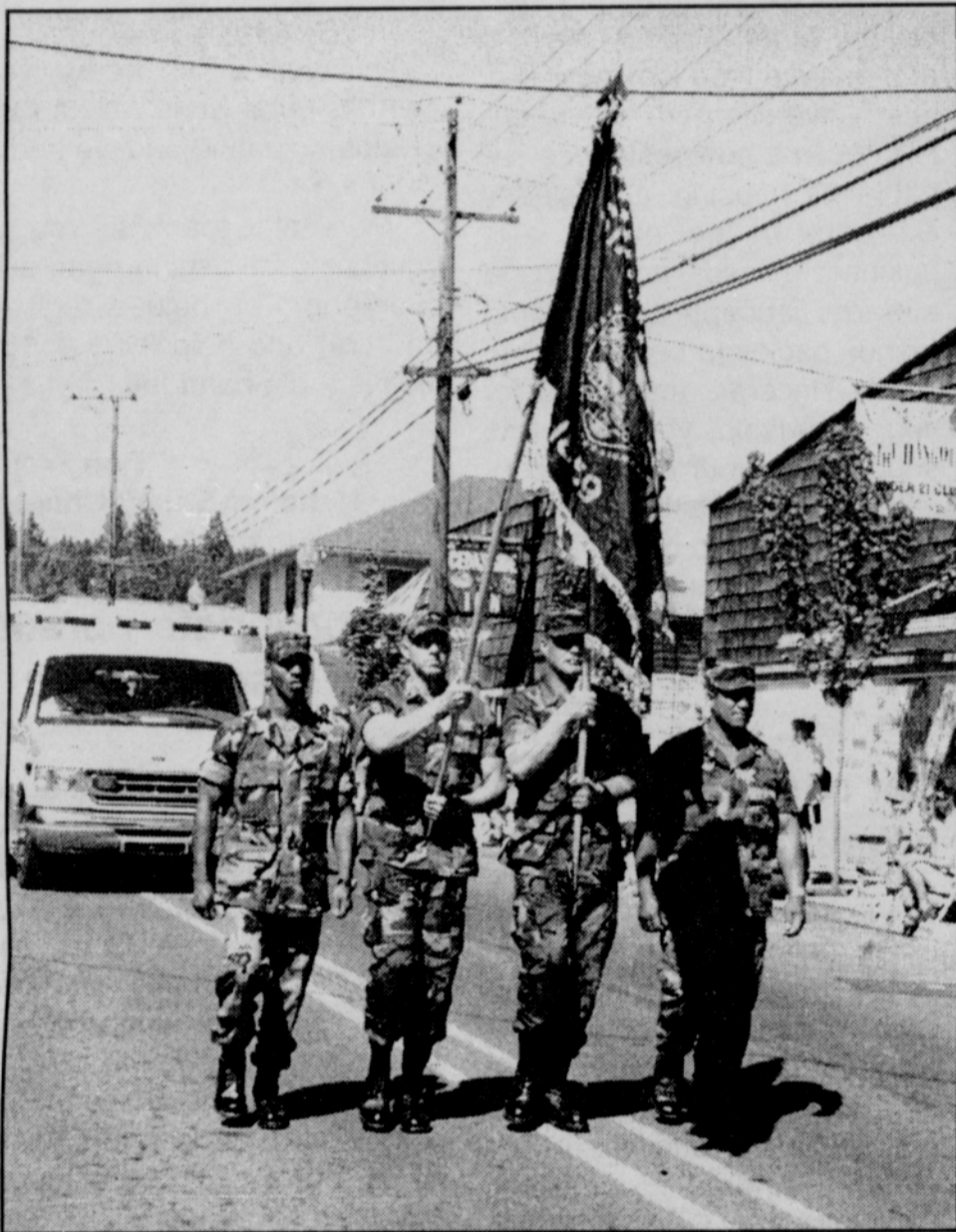


## 2000 Jamboree parade



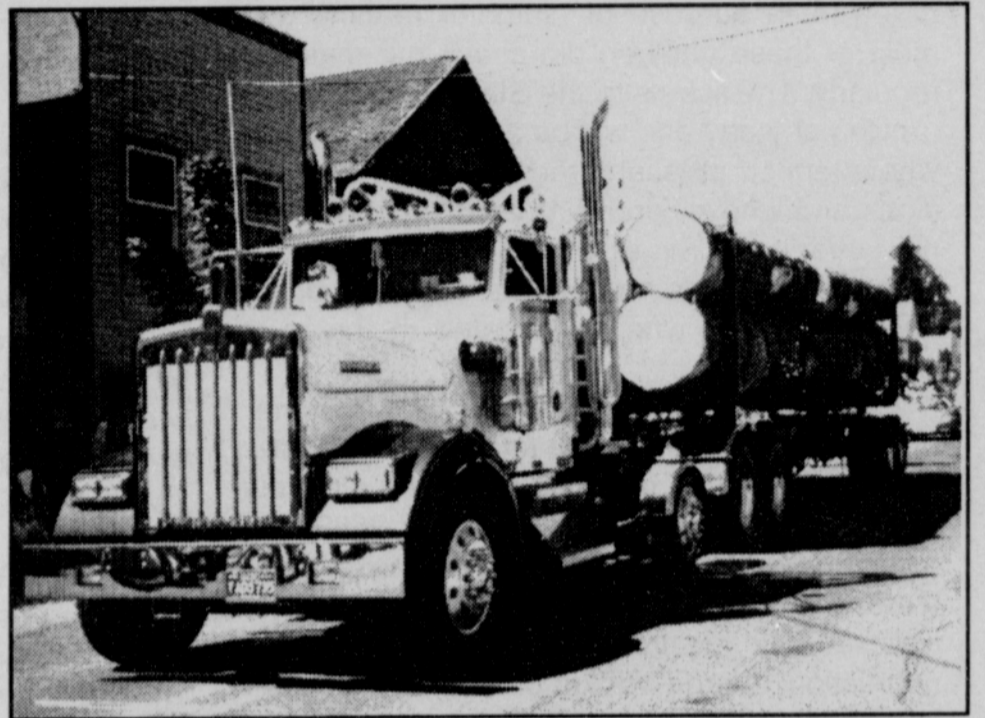

first of the funds in approximately 45 days. Green said that WOEC would continue to look for opportunities for growth in order to give better and lower cost service to its members.

Unfortunately, not all went smoothly in preparation for the annual meeting. There were three ballot measures and three director positions up for

election. The ballots addressed to the members in the Chapman area were not delivered by annual meeting day, even though they had been received by the post office in plenty of time. The results of the ballot measures and the Chapman area directorship could not be announced because that part of the election is not yet final. Ballots will be mailed again to that area. The Chapman por-

tion of the meetings will be reconvened at the Sept. 19 board meeting. The final results will be announced at that meeting.

Results of the other two director elections were unaffected by the mailing error. Bernie Bird and Sam Hearing, who both ran unopposed in their districts were re-elected.


