Cold can kill; know how to stay safe when its cold

If you think it's cold now, just wait. Forecasters are predicting one of the coldest winters in years and that can lead to more people at risk for hypothermia. Hypothermia occurs when the body's core temperature lowers due to the cold, but it can also occur at mild temperatures, if exposure is prolonged. Pacific North-

westerners are especially at risk for several reasons: the popularity of outdoor winter sports, combined with fewer people wearing protective gear, continually rainy conditions that lead to wet clothing and temperatures that frequently hit the freezing point. Providence St. Vincent Medical Center Emergency Department physicians

have information about who is at highest risk and what should be done to prevent hypothermia and how to provide relief for someone who is showing symptoms.
