1. Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 14, 2001, at or after 10:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, Room 308 on the Third Floor of the Columbia County Courthouse, in St. Helens, Oregon.

2. The purpose of this hearing will be to consider proposed Ordinance No. 2000-3, which would amend the Columbia County Surface Mining Ordinance. If approved, Ordinance No. 2001-3 would provide a process for Operating Permit and Limited Exemption Certificate renewals in a manner consistent with Oregon land use law.

3. Copies of the proposed amendments are available in the Planning Department. The proposed ordinance may be amended at the public hearing.
