

Final week for display of student art work at state Capitol

A selection of student artwork from 25 schools throughout Oregon is included in "Transformations", an exhibit currently featured in the State Capitol gallery in Salem. The exhibit was organized by the Oregon Arts Commission.

"This exhibit demonstrates the incredible use of the arts to support learning across the curriculum," said Kathleen Davis, of Medford, commission vice-chair. "A great deal of evi-

dence shows us that the participation of student in schools with strong arts programs improves the chance for overall student success."

Artwork was selected from elementary, middle and high schools across the state. Featured works represent a wide variety of student expression and art experiences, including architecture, mask making, photography, painting, drawing, wood collage and mixed

media.

Several Arts Commission education partners were involved in developing the exhibit, including the Regional Arts Education Network, which offers artist residencies and leadership, the organizations involved in its Arts Reaching Youth initiative, which provide focused arts training to youth at risk, and classroom teachers

with special expertise in the arts and their connection to other subject areas.

The show is open to the public through February 24. The gallery exhibit space in

the State Capitol at 900 State Street is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 to 5:00 p.m., Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Sunday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.


