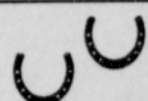

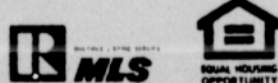

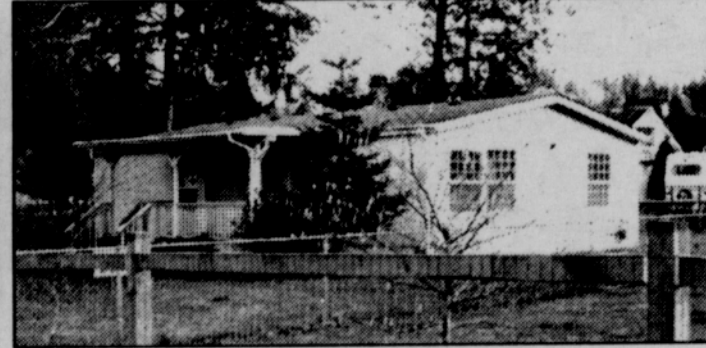

1. The Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 21, 2001, at or after 10:00 a.m., in the Commissioners' Meeting Room, Room 308, Third Floor, Columbia County Courthouse in St. Helens, Oregon.

2. The purpose of the hearing is the appli-

cation of The Confederated Tribes of the Grande Ronde Community of Oregon, P. O. Box 10, Grande Ronde, Oregon, for a Surface Mining Operating Permit, #05-0075.

3. The subject property is identified on the Assessor's records as tax account #4304-000-0100. The parcel is zoned PF-76 - Primary Forest and has a conditional use permit (CU 98-31) to allow surface mining. The

property is located approximately 8 miles east of Vernonia off the Scappoose-Vernonia Highway. The subject property consists of approximately 665 acres. If approved, the proposed surface mining operation would consist of approximately 56 acres.

4. All interested parties may appear and be heard.
