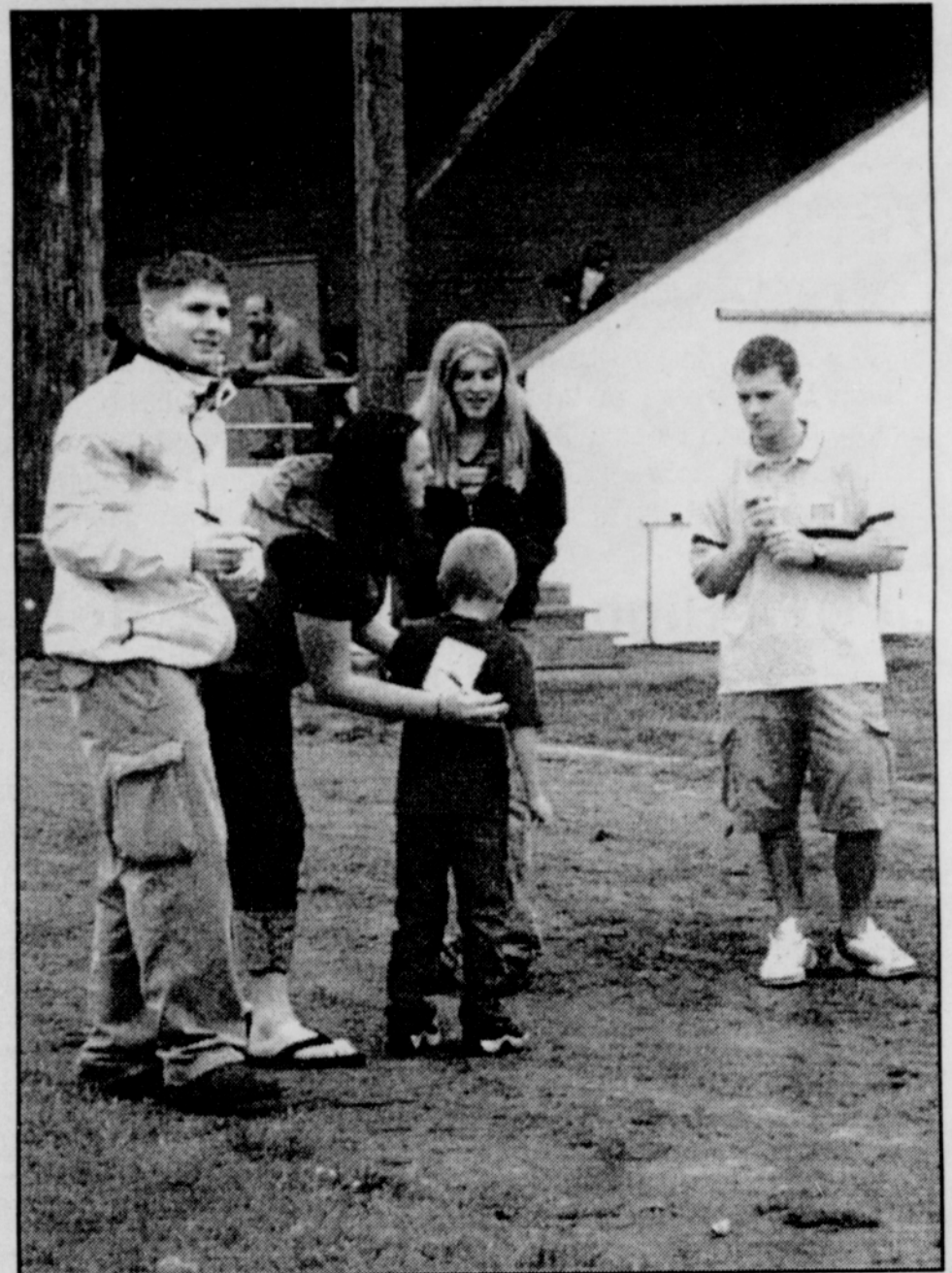


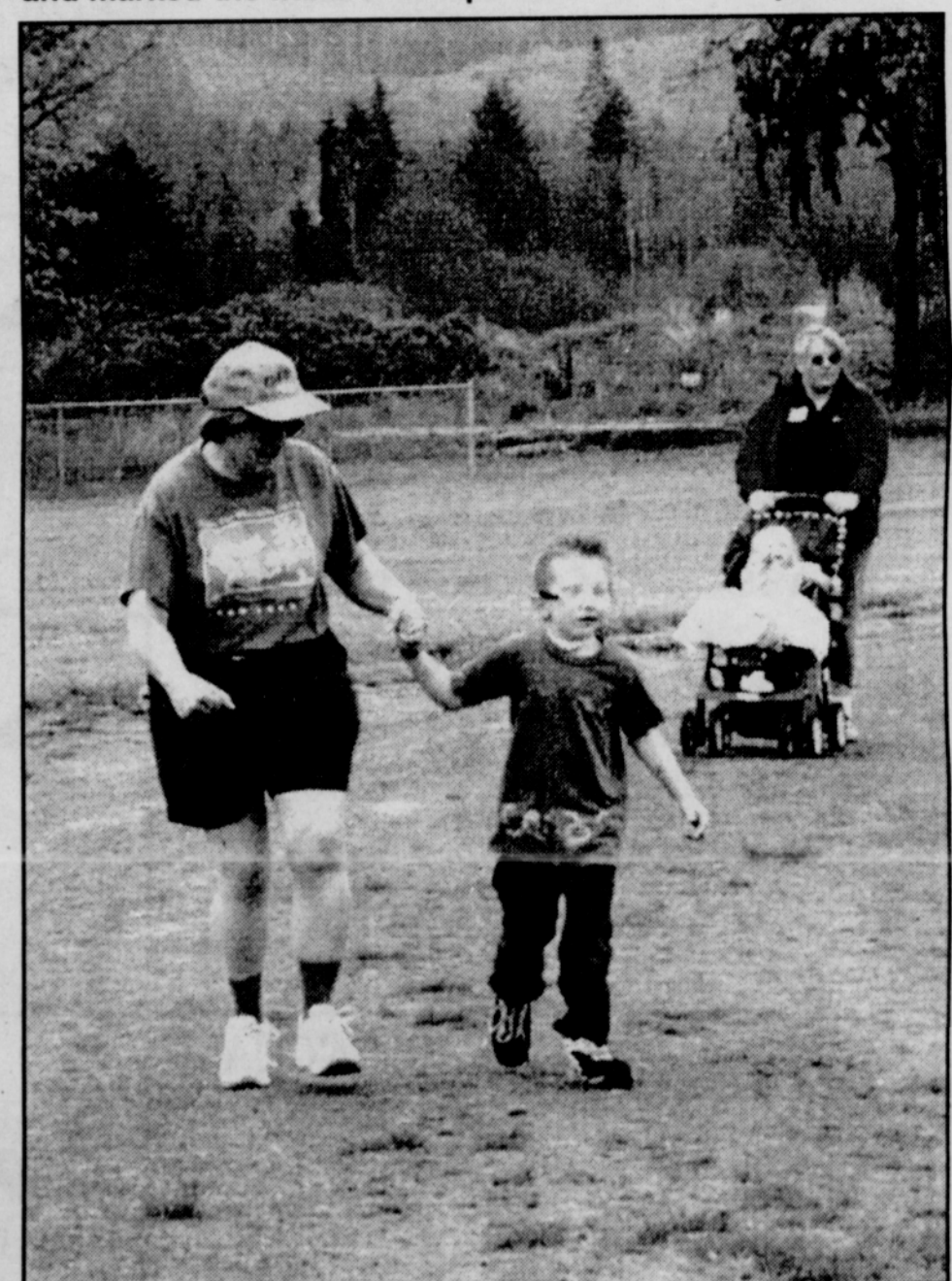
Vernonia's first Run for the Arts draws many eager participants
