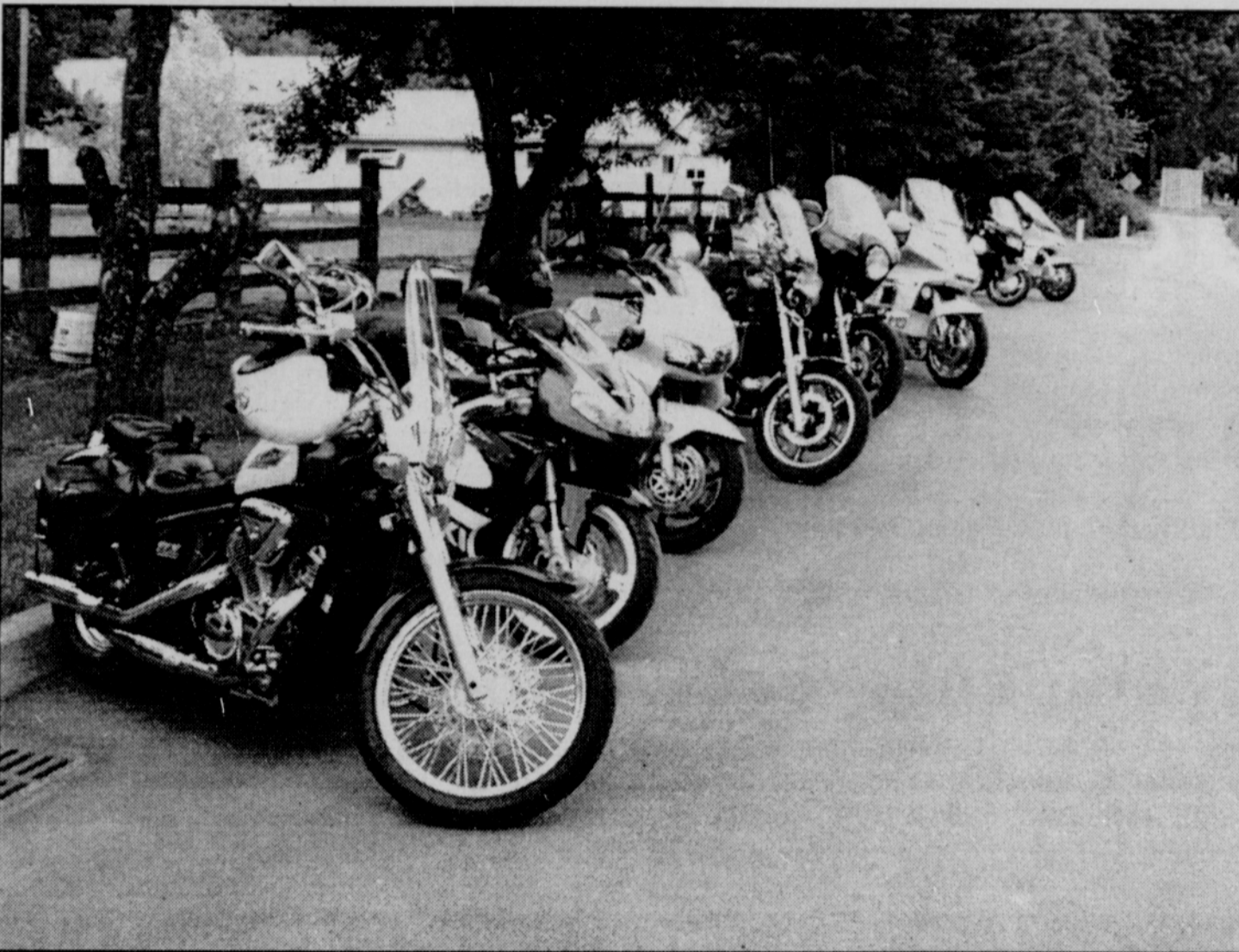
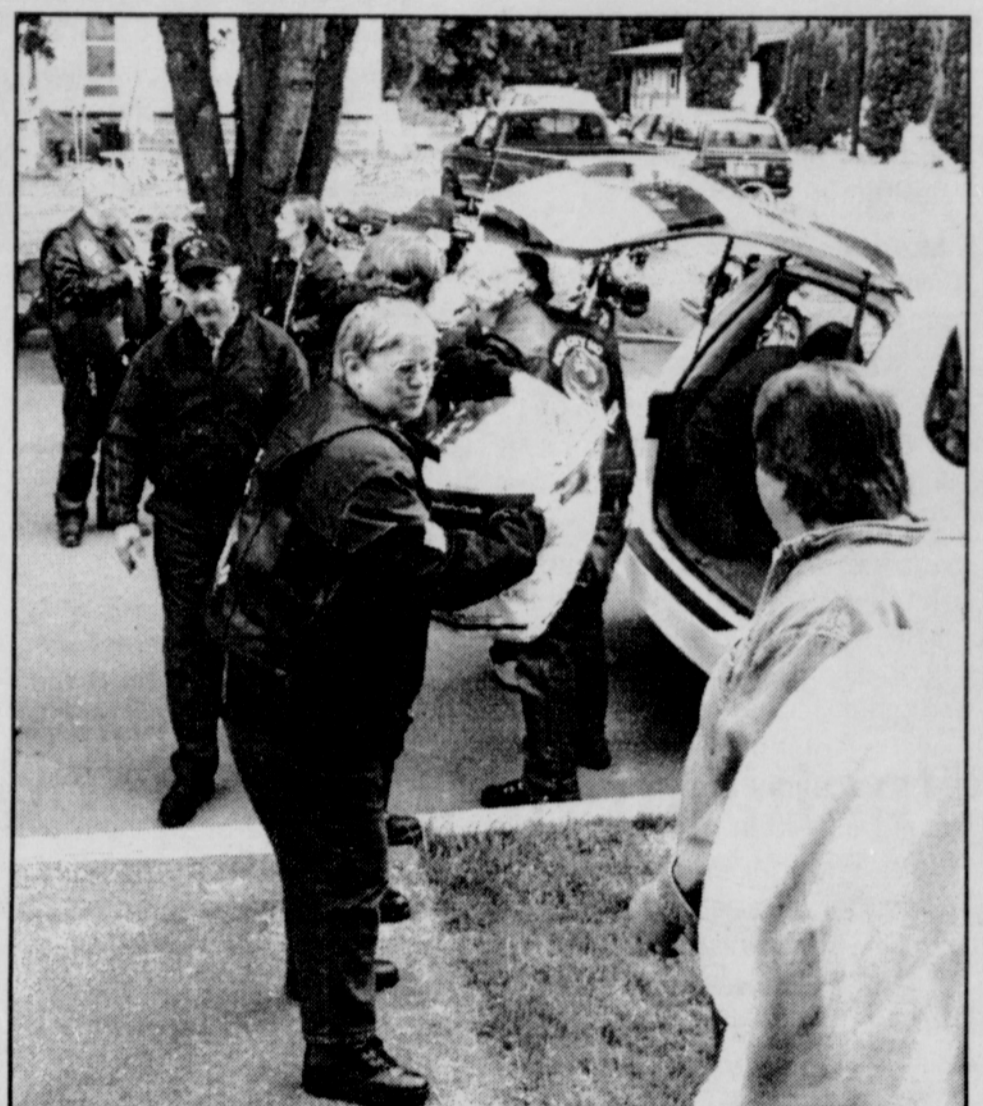


## Motorcycle club's donations continue to help feed needy people

Clatskanie's annual Heritage Days celebration will get underway June 30 with the Heritage Cruise Car Show, Pie in the Park, Mayor's Walk Against Hunger, and a Mountain Men Encampment.

The celebration will reach its peak on the 4th of July, with a hometown parade followed by a logging show, barbecue, fun center, an outdoor concert

with Johnny Limbo & the Lugnuts, and a spectacular fireworks display.

Over 250 antique and collector cars from throughout the Pacific Northwest are expected at the Clatskanie Cruisers Car Club's 11th annual Heritage Cruise Car Show, 10 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Saturday, June 30, in the Clatskanie City Park, one block off Highway 30 in downtown Clatskanie.

Other Heritage Days activities in the park on June 30 will include the taste-tempting Pie in the Park baking contest and pie sale sponsored by Clatskanie Chapter P.E.O., and the Mayor's Walk Against Hunger spearheaded by Clatskanie Mayor Chip Waisanen and the Turning Point Community Center.

Across the Clatskanie River in the Black Dog Clan Mountain Men Encampment, which will continue through the 4th of July, visitors are invited to travel back in time to the American West of the 1820s to 1840s where living history re-enactors in period costumes will demonstrate the mountain man way of life including trading tables, singing, dancing, drumming, knife and tomahawk throwing contests, and more.

Saturday, June 30, will also see the final performance of "The Mouse That Roared," by the Clatskanie High School

Drama Club, in the Donavon Wooley Performing Arts Center at Clatskanie High School, 471 SW Bel Air Drive. Curtain time is 7:30 p.m. Other performances will be June 22, 23 and 29.

An All-School Reunion for everyone who ever attended, taught at or were otherwise associated with Clatskanie area schools is set for Sunday, July 1, beginning at 12 noon in the Clatskanie City Park, with lots of visiting and reminiscing.

*Neighbors - The Heart of Community* is the theme of the annual 4th of July parade, which will march down Nehalem Street at 11 a.m. and end in Clatskanie City Park. Oren Tweet, a Clatskanie city councilor for over 30 years and a leader in the town's tradition of community service, will lead the parade as grand marshal.

After the parade, featured activities in or near the city park will include the Heritage Logging Show beginning at 1 p.m., the first of four competitions which will end with the crowning of the Logger of the Year at the Vernonia Jamboree; the Kiwanis Chicken Barbecue, a Fun Center, booths, concessions, free kayaking on the Clatskanie River, the mountain men encampment, the golden oldies rock 'n roll concert by Johnny Limbo & the Lugnuts from 6 to 9 p.m., and the fireworks spectacular at dark.
