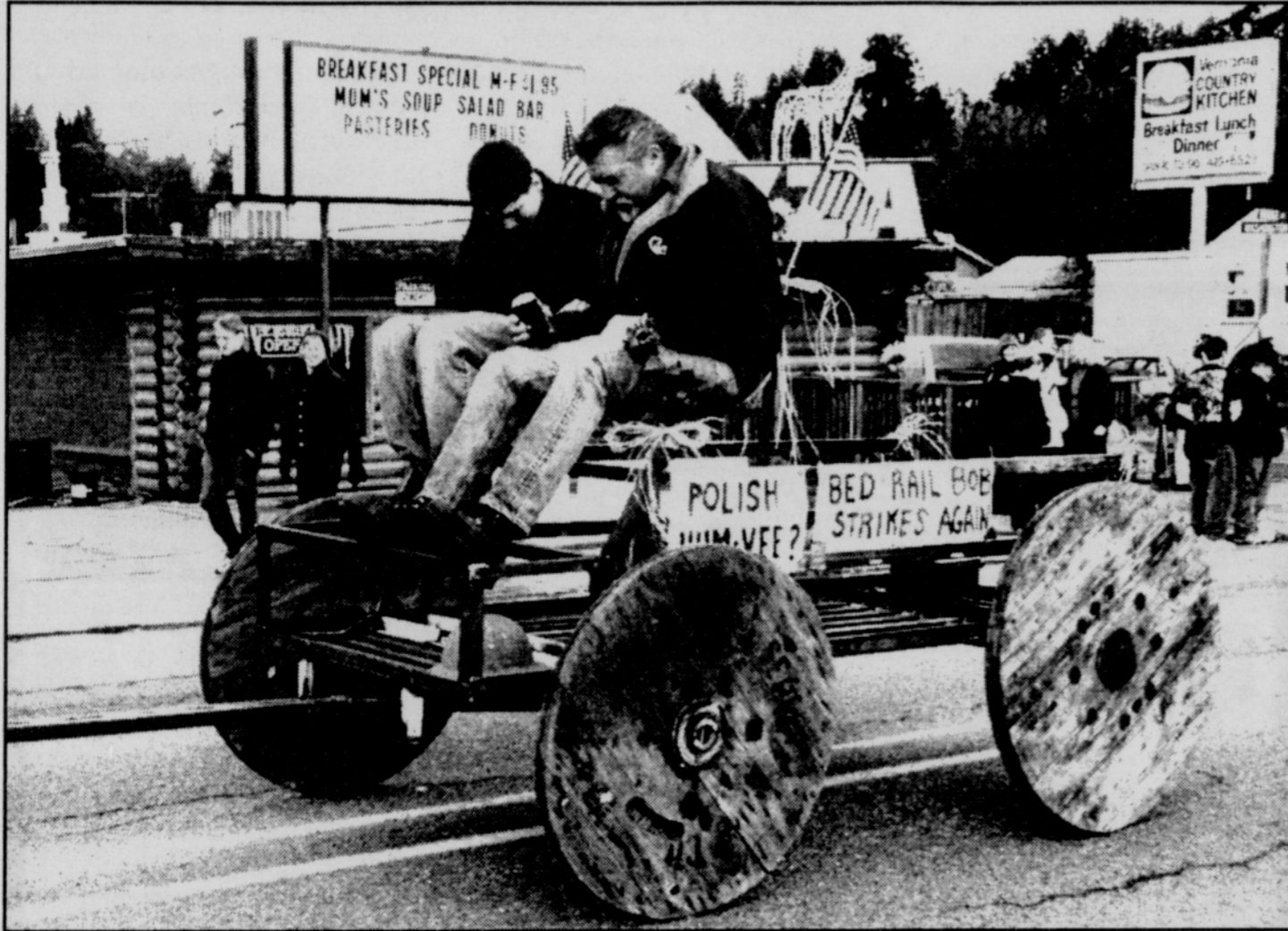
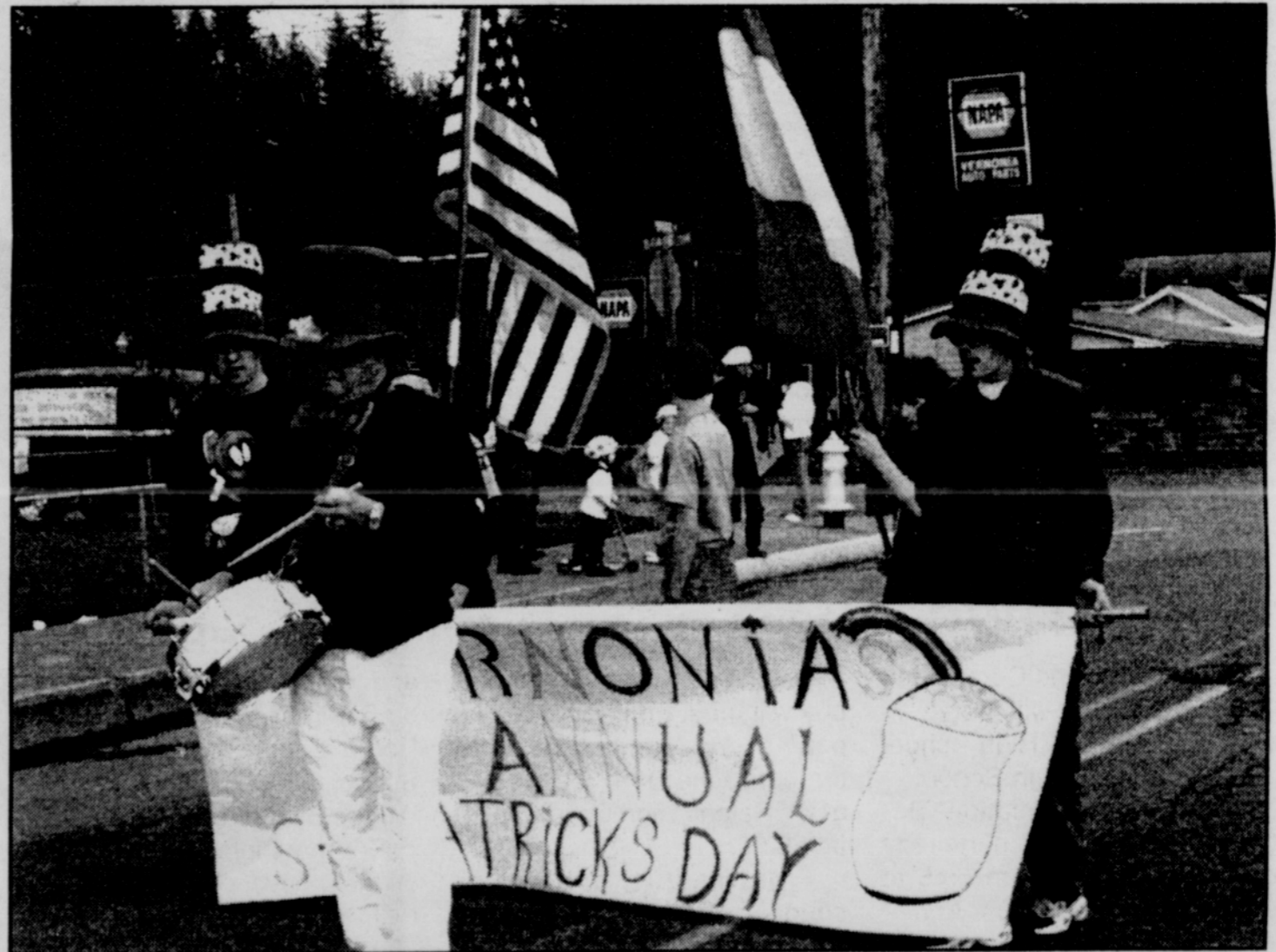


St. Patrick's Day Parade in Vernonia is mostly about having fun
