Lights will go out at midnight so that everyone can get some sleep.

Babysitting will be provided Friday night, August 2, and Saturday night, August 3, from 7:00 p.m. until 8:00 a.m. the following morning. Children may be dropped off as late as 9:00 p.m. However, the doors will be locked and no child will be released between 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Any child staying after 1:00 a.m. will be charged the overnight rate.

She is the daughter of Claudia Ryan of Vernonia.

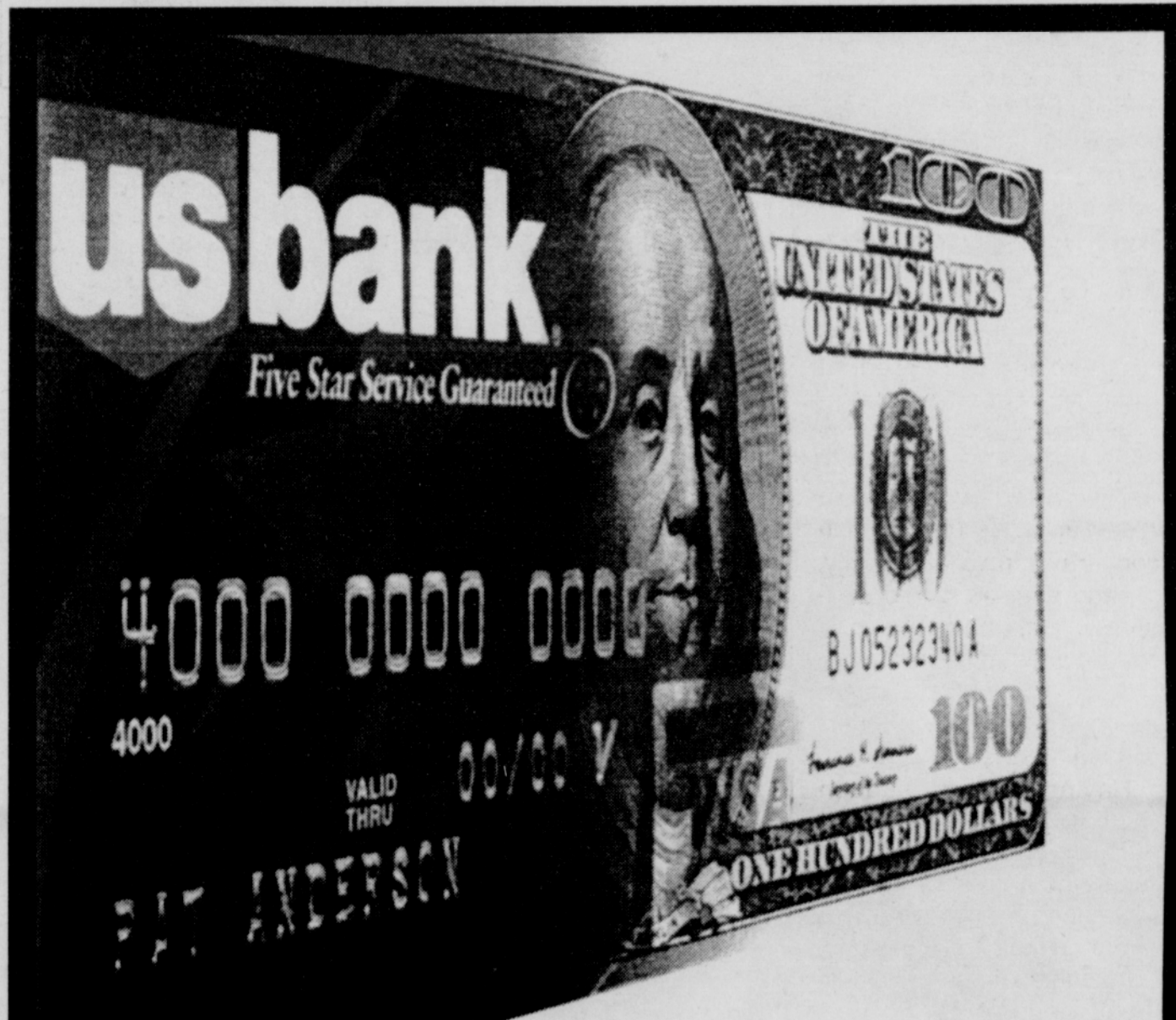
Eve Morgan on George Fox Dean's List
