Guidelines for free or reduced-price school lunches

Eligibility for free and reduced-price meals for students in schools operating the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs is determined by household size and income. In some cases, foster children are eligible for benefits regardless of household income.

Qualifying students receive meals or milk without charge or at a reduced price of no more than 40 cents for lunch.

Children from households with incomes at or below the following levels are eligible for free or reduced-price meals or free milk:

Children in households receiving Food Stamps, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) or Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR) are eligible for free meals. In August, the Department of Human Services (DHS) sends a notice/certifica-

tion letter to households receiving Food Stamp benefits advising them of their eligibility at participating schools. The DHS notice/certification letter is proof of eligibility. No other application or verification of eligibility is required for students listed on the DHS notification letter.

Households not submitting the DHS letter may complete a confidential application for free or reduced-price meals which will be reviewed by a school official to determine eligibility. Applications may be submitted anytime during the year. For more information, contact your school office.
