

CCCHD starts small grant program for non-profit or public groups

Non-profit or public groups are eligible to apply for local grants of up to \$500 through the Columbia County Citizens for Human Dignity Community Grant Program.

Types of projects that will be

considered are arts and cultural projects, health and social service projects, educational and community outreach projects, seed money for new projects, collaborative projects between agencies, and short-term

funding to address a current need area. All projects must advance social justice in Columbia County and support CCCHD's mission statements, which is to work to assure basic civil rights and human dignity for all.

Funds for the grants were raised from the Kaleidoscope Winter Gala in January. CCCHD decided to return some of these funds to the community in the form of local grants.

Non-profit or publicly funded organizations such as educa-

tional institutions, social service agencies and human rights or charitable organizations are eligible to apply for the grants. Also, loosely constructed organizations such as an informal group of citizens wanting to fund a local, short-term project.

The organization or project must operate within Columbia County, with local decision-making and be of benefit to Columbia County citizens. Grant money cannot be used to deliver existing social services, but is available to social service

programs to address barriers to social justice. Grants cannot be used for political organizations or campaigns, annual fund drives, endowments or capital expenditures.

The first round of grants will be awarded in January, 2003, although more grants will be awarded throughout the year, if funds are available.
