Hwy 47 crash takes life of driver



The driver of this pickup truck was killed when he crossed the center line and crashed into a log truck.

Frank Douglas Heppner, 46, St. Helens, was fatally injured in a crash October 18, on Hwy 47 near Big Eddy Park.

Preliminary investigation by the Oregon State Police indicated that Heppner was driving a 2000 Ford pickup truck southbound when it crossed the double yellow centerline into the path of a northbound log truck driven by Bryan Englehaupt, 35, of Dallas. The log truck, which was not loaded, flipped onto its side and the pickup

truck went down an embankment on the southbound side. Englehaupt suffered minor injuries; he was treated and released at St. Vincent Hospital in Portland.

Vernonia Police Department and State Police Troopers from Banks and Astoria assisted in the investigation. Additional assistance was provided by the Oregon Department of Transportation, Vernonia Fire and Rescue and Mist Fire and Rescue.

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
