The Board of County Commissioners is requesting interested persons to volunteer to serve on its Special Transportation Fund (STF) Advisory Committee. The purpose of the STF Advisory Committee is to advise and assist the Board in financing and improving transportation programs and services for the elderly and disabled residents of Columbia County.

To be qualified to serve on the STF Advisory Committee, the volunteer must:

1. Reside within the boundaries of the County; and must be:

2. (A) A person who is an elderly or disabled individual and uses transportation services in the County;

(B) A person who is an elderly or disabled individual and lives in an area of the County where there are no public transportation services;

(C) An individual engaged in providing transportation services to the elderly or disabled in the County;

(D) A representative of elderly individuals; or

(E) A representative of disabled individuals.

The STF Advisory Committee shall review the distribution of moneys by the Board and may propose any changes to the policies or practices of the Board relating to the distribution that the committee considers necessary or desirable.
