- Missing Pieces, 58605 Nehalem Hwy So. (on Hwy 47 next to Storage, Too): Offering an eclectic selection of old and antique collectables and vintage goods from the late 1800s to the early 1900s. Lots of goodies are hidden away here and, who knows, maybe you'll find some of those "missing pieces."

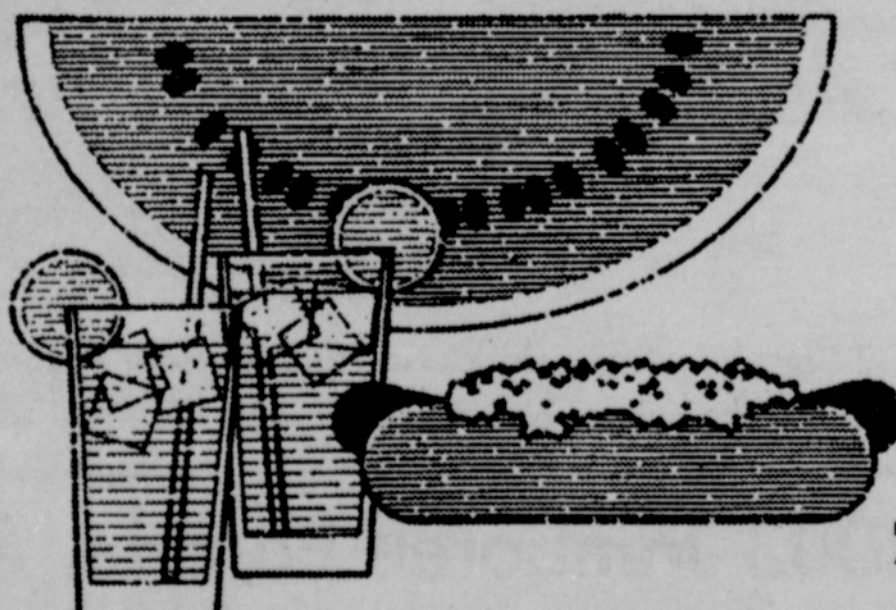
