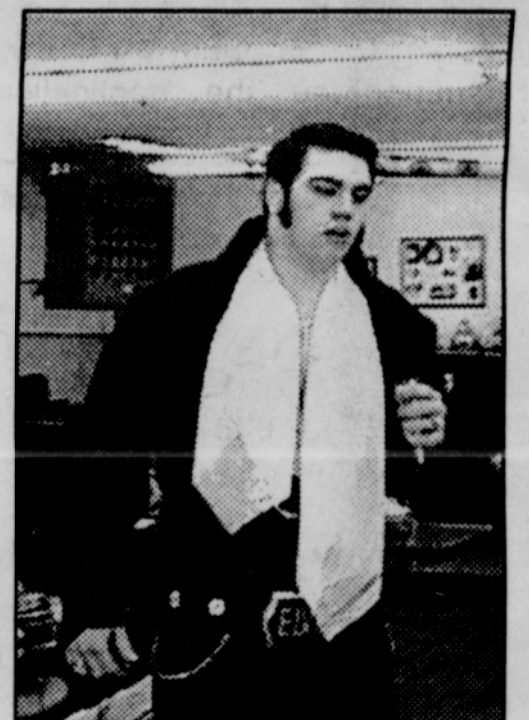
Teen dance to be held Saturday in VHS gym
