Learn about college degree

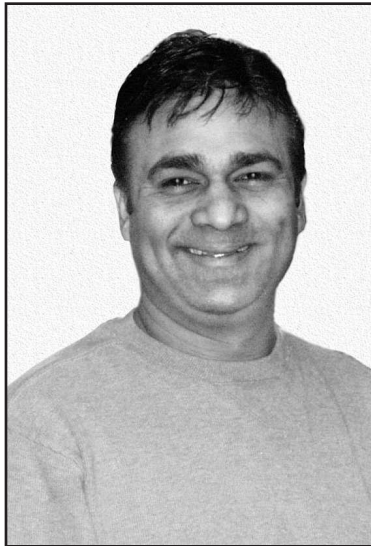
