47J panel to review transportation needs

Early this year, while reviewing staff contracts, Vernonia school district formed a committee to review the transportation contract. While making clear that they were more than satisfied with the services provided by Curl Transportation, the board felt that a review was in order because the contract was originally signed in 1984, and has since been amended to the point that it is a confusing conglomeration of documents. Last year the board chose not to renew the rolling five-year contract, leaving four years remaining (through the 2007-2008 school year).

Board members Randy Hansen and Cari Levenseller, and Superintendent Mike Funderburg have been working on a revision since January. Following review by all members of the board in February, a contract was mailed to Curl Transportation in March as a starting point for formal negotiation. The committee has met with Joe Curl at least four times. No agreement has been reached on a contract revision; the current contract will be in effect for the next four school years.

However, the board reached a consensus that the committee could act to enforce the existing contract without further action by the board. For instance, the contract requires Curl Transportation to have five buses available for regular, daily school transportation that are less than 15 years old. This provision will require one bus to be replaced at the end of this year and another at the end of next year. Curl Transportation is not required to purchase new buses.

According to Superintendent Mike Funderburg, the district will open the transportation contract for proposals when the current contract is due to expire.
