Extension schedules class on well water and septic tank management

Who is responsible for your well water and septic tank? YOU ARE! Rural residents are usually responsible for their own drinking water and waste water systems. According to Gail Andrews, coordinator of the OSU Well Water Program, proper care will protect your family's health, your homestead investment, and our water resource for the future, but unfortunately, many people lack the information necessary to safely maintain these sys-

Andrews is teaching a free class on how to maintain drinking water, wells and septic systems. The "Rural Living Basics" class will be held at Scappoose High School in the cafeteria on Wednesday, October 27 from 6:30 to 9:00 p.m.

Free screening of well water for nitrate will be offered as part of the class. Bring about a cup untreated well water in a

clean container and it will be tested while you attend the class. Andrews points out that, while it is especially important for households with pregnant women or newborns to test for nitrate because of a rare type of blue-baby syndrome, all homes with private wells should be aware of their nitrate level. Nitrate test results will be provided at the end of the

Register by calling the Columbia County Extension Service at 503-397-3462.

Doors open 30 minutes before the class. Those attending are encouraged to arrive early to drop off a water sample for the nitrate test, ask questions, and enjoy refreshments.
