A public hearing is scheduled before the Vernonia Planning Commission on January 20, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 1001 Bridge Street, Vernonia, Oregon, to consider a variance submitted by the Vernonia School District from the parking provisions and maximum building length provisions of Vernonia Ordinance 711 and consideration of expansion of a conditional use permit to construct a 16,000 square foot Middle School with a future Phase Two 5,600 square foot gymnasium at the Vernonia 4-J School District property located at 475 Bridge Street on Tax Lot #4404-031-00100. 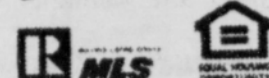
