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Three new members sought for Children and Families Commission

Washington County is seeking applications for new members to fill three vacancies on the Commission on Children and Families (CCF).

The Commission works with many partners to look at conditions that affect children and families, and recommends strategies and funding to improve those conditions. Part of a statewide network of commissions, the CCF recommends funding for key services for children and families and administers a small grants fund to support the development of assets in the community.

The fifteen members, representing the geographic and cultural diversity of the county, must commit 5 to 10 hours per month. At least eight of the members must be lay citizens who do not derive income from children and family services. Commission members are appointed by the County Board of Commissioners and must be Washington County residents.
