The 2006 rally will again be run from Hillsboro, with competitors facing the challenge of northwest Oregon forest roads. Next year will mark the "passing of the torch" for the role of event chairman.

Matt Tabor, who was assistant chairman for the 2005 event, will fill the position being vacated by former Chairman Ben Bradley. "Ben has led the



