again. The intent of the ordinance is to develop an enforcement mechanism to make the abatements permanent.

Council is pursuing a fine of \$1000 per day against property owner Thomas Lepschat, who has been repeatedly cited for noncompliance.

COPS Grant repayment

The repayment of COPS funds continues to be an issue. Lucas sent a letter to the US Department of Justice explaining the hardship that repaying

Air Force Airman Caleb B. Powell has graduated from basic military training at Lackland Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas.

\$58,819.78 would cause the City of Banks, noting that insufficient time was allowed to study the validity of the debt, and protesting that seven years had elapsed between the disbursal of the grant and the finding of noncompliance.
