WOEC meeting hears of satellite internet

A good crowd turned out for the annual meeting of West Oregon Electric Cooperative last Saturday at the Scout Cabin in Vernonia. It was also the first opportunity for most of those attending to meet the new General Manager Marc Farmer.

Director David Hess was reelected to represent District 7. Randall Aultman, a retired school administrator who had been appointed to fill the remainder of Sam Hearing's

term, was elected to the District 3 directorship over Vernonia newcomer Leon Bluestone, who retired after working 35 years in the power industry.

Royce Hagelstein, WOEC Chief Financial Officer, presented a positive financial report, the result of a mild weather year with no major storm damage. No rate increase is presently anticipated but, until Bonneville Power Administration sets wholesale rates, stable rates are tenuous.

A few years ago, WOEC joined NoaNet, a consortium of public power agencies which planned to provide broad band internet to their members via fiber-optic cable. This venture resulted in a financial loss for WOEC, though not from operating funds. A large portion of the two-million dollars that WOEC received in a negotiated settlement over PGE service territories in Columbia County provided the investment funds.

Now WOEC is involved with "Wild Blue", another consortium of public power agencies which is working to develop satellite internet for members who cannot access broad band internet from remote areas.

One member questioned whether WOEC is again investing in a venture that is already technologically "behind the curve," as was done with NoaNet. Farmer, who has extensive experience in rural telecommunications, explained that the satellite for Wild Blue has already been launched and, furthermore, that both alpha and beta testing have been completed. In addition, he said, WOEC's arrangement with Wild Blue did not require a large financial investment.

Other topics discussed were the amount of bad debt written off annually (approximately .05 percent) and the facility charge.

Members also enjoyed lunch and many door prizes.
