### Notice of Receipt of Ballot Title

#### PROPOSED BALLOT TITLE

CAPTION: Prohibits all non-emergency County Services for Minors Unless Parent Consents.

QUESTION: Shall Columbia County be required to obtain consent of a parent before providing non-emergency public services to a minor?

STATEMENT: Columbia County provides or administers public services which are intended to aid minor children. These include health, education and counseling services. This ordinance would require that before such services could be provided to a minor child, the County would be required to obtain the consent of at least one parent or legal guardian of the minor child. Emergency services would be exempt from this requirement.

The ordinance would define "parent," "minor child," and "emergency services."

"Parent" and "minor child" are as defined by Oregon Revised Statutes. "Emergency services" are defined in

the ordinance as services provided immediately to a minor child when the minor child is in danger of loss of life or serious physical injury.

The State of Oregon would act as parent of any minor child in State custody or whose parent or guardian was charged with child abuse or neglect.

This ordinance would not impair current County contractual agreements but would affect all renewals or new contracts.

In accordance with O.R.S. 250.168 (2), the proposed initiative meets the requirements of Section 1 (2)(d), Article IV of the Oregon Constitution.

Also, in accordance with O.R.S. 250.175 (5), notice is hereby given that an elector may file a petition for review of the ballot title in the Columbia County Circuit Court no later than 5:00 p.m. on July 14, 2006, which is the date of the 7th business day after receipt (O.R.S. 250.195).
