Vernonia CERT will have a booth during Jamboree at Bridge St. and Jefferson Ave., with information on emergency preparedness and response.

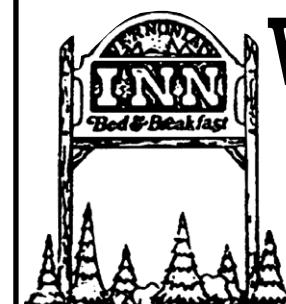
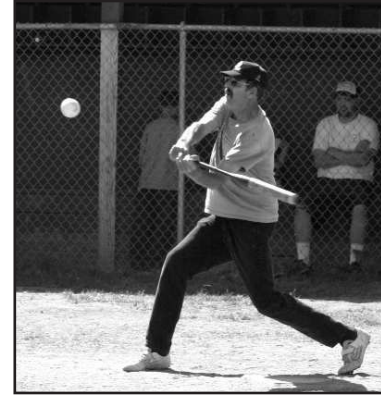
